HB 4046

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/3/2012 AGENDA - FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Exempts certain accident only, specified disease and hospital indemnity insurance policies from payment of assessment on gross amount of premiums.

HB 4127 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/3/2012 AGENDA - FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Oregon Health Authority adopt standards and procedures to certify specified mental health providers to qualify for insurance reimbursement.

HB 4074 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Permits insurers, multiple employer welfare arrangements, health care service contractors and self-insured employee health benefit plans to offer health benefit plan that pays cash dividends to enrollee who participates in wellness program.

HB 4122 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires pharmacy benefit managers conducting business in Oregon to obtain license from and annually renew license with State Board of Pharmacy.

HB 4128

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires health benefit plans to cover medically necessary dental or orthodontic services for treatment of craniofacial anomalies.

HB 4135

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires insurer, if rate filing represents specified premium rate increase, to send notice to affected policyholders and persons who requested notification.

Work Session

HB 4164

Requires Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation to establish and deposit moneys into accounts in federally insured depositories.
