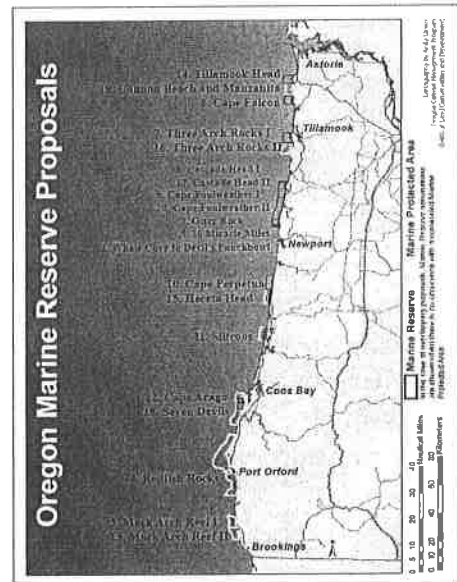

Background

- **Executive Order 08-07**
 - Nine or fewer sites
 - Ecologically meaningful
 - Avoid significant socio-economic hardship
- **Ocean Policy Advisory Council (OPAC)**
 - 20 public proposals



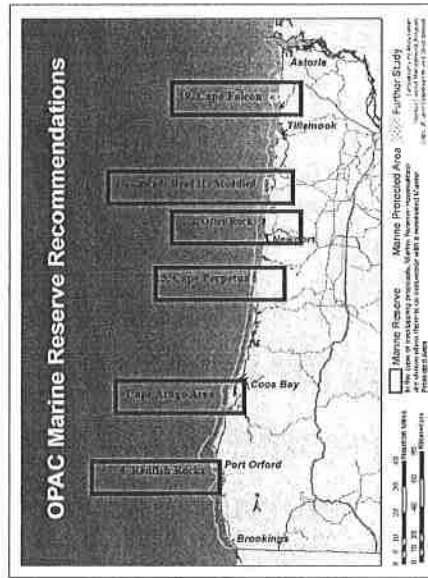

- Area for new proposal 

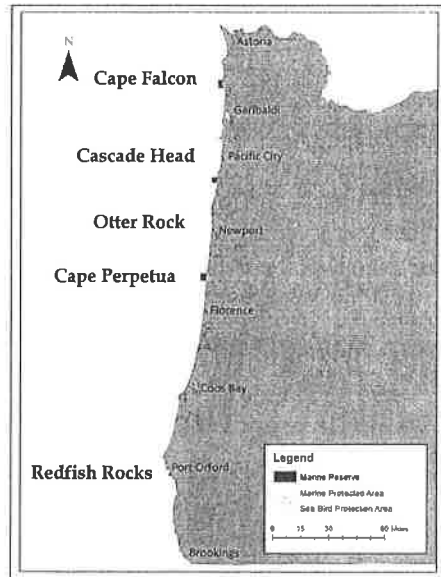
- **HB 3013 (2009)**

- Sponsored by Coastal Caucus
- Designate pilot sites
- Further evaluate w/community team
- ODFW consult w/STAC & OPAC
- ODFW report to Legislature



SB 1510 Marine Reserves

- Continue implementing Otter Rock and Redfish Rocks sites
- Implement Cape Perpetua, Cascade Head and Cape Falcon sites
- Use local resources for implementation
- Do not impose prohibitions until baseline studies complete
- Report on workplan and expenditures by 2/1/13
- Report on MR results after 10 years



Implementation – SB 1510

- 2011 Session: budget and spending limitation for FY11-13
- Rule making spring/summer 2012
- Delay prohibitions until baseline data collected (2+yrs)
- Continue public/stakeholder involvement
- Use local resources for implementation
- Work w/feds and research toward providing additional fishing opportunities (e.g., stock assessments, methods to reduce bycatch and discard mortality)
- Report on workplan and spending by 2/13
- STAC report on results after 10 years

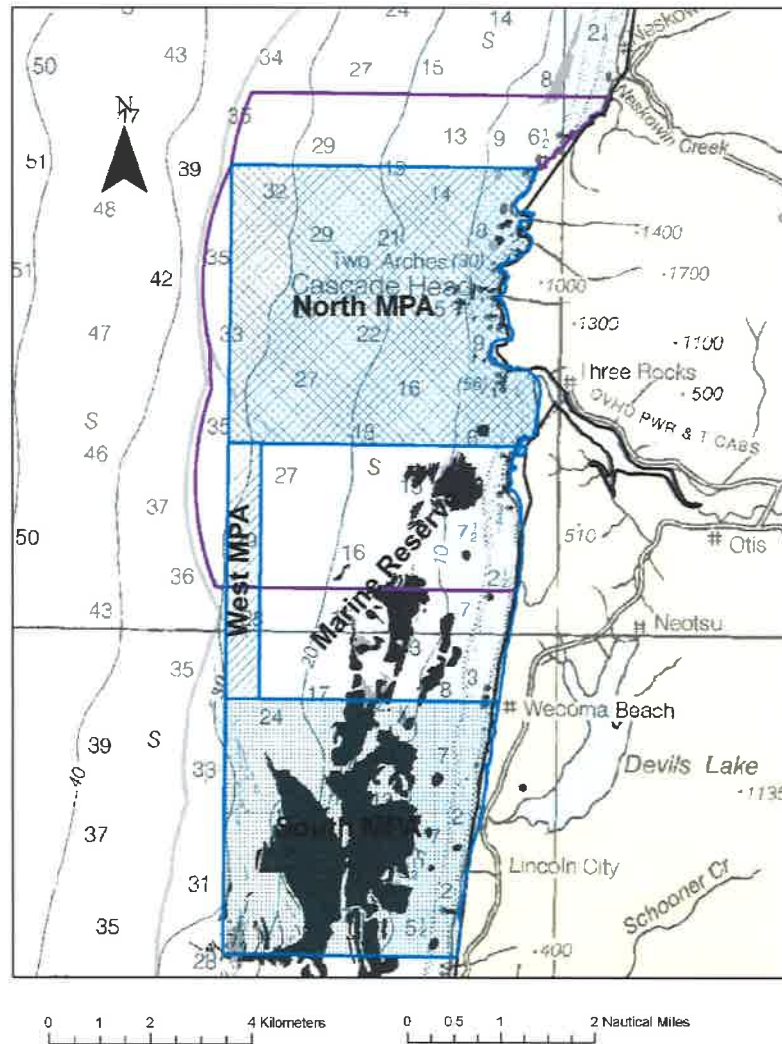

Cascade Head Marine Reserve Recommendation



West MPA:

Allowances: Commercial and sport crab & salmon. All other extractive activities (including new ocean development) prohibited.

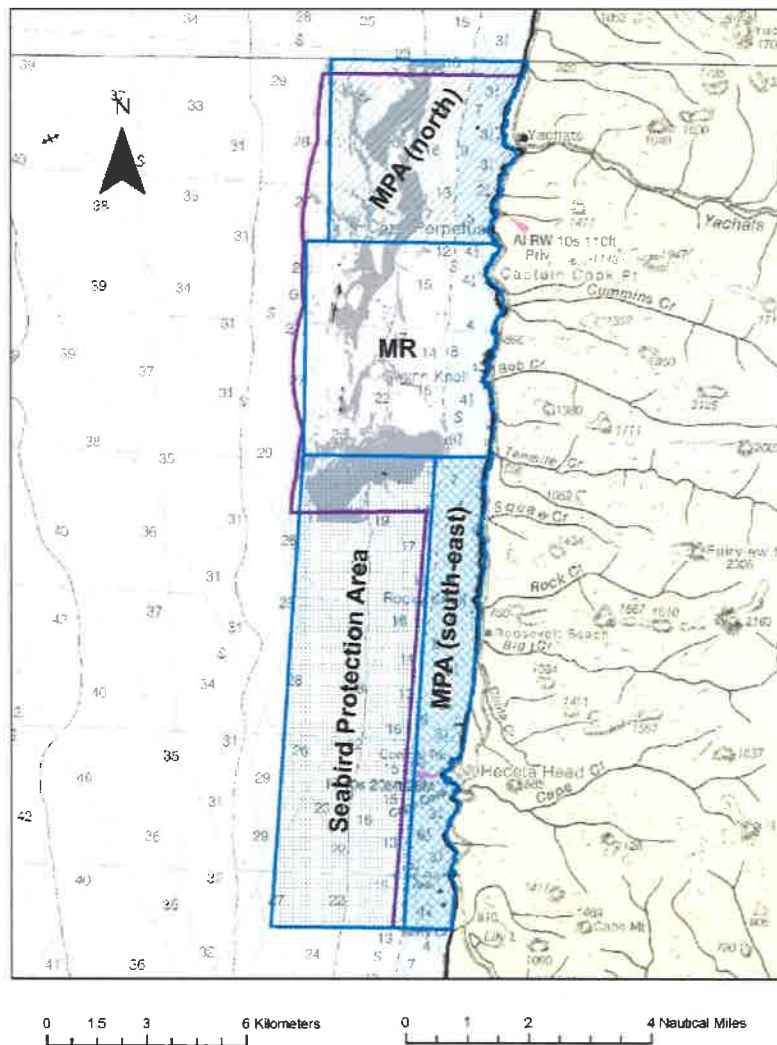
North MPA:

Allowances: Commercial and sport crab & salmon, and sport groundfish fishing for fishermen launching out of Knight Park (Salmon River). All other extractive activities (including new ocean development) prohibited.

South MPA:

Allowances: All activities allowed in current regulations except: trawl, nets, and new ocean development

Cape Perpetua Marine Reserve Recommendation



North MPA:

Allowances: Commercial and sport crab and salmon, and shoreside recreational fishing. All other extractive activities (including new ocean development) prohibited.

South-east MPA:

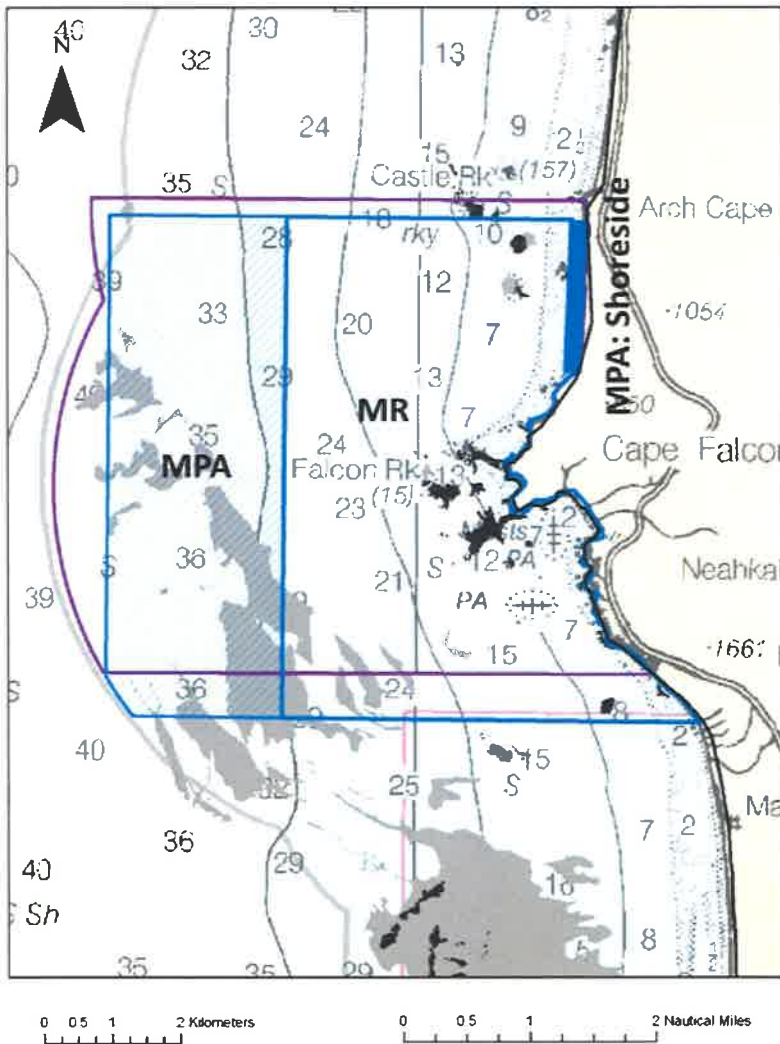
Allowances: All activities allowed in current regulations except: trawl, all forage fish fisheries, and new ocean development.

Other: Management plan developed to minimize bird disturbance.

Seabird Protection Area (SPA):

Allowances: All activities allowed in current regulations except: forage fin fish fisheries, new ocean development

Cape Falcon Marine Reserve Recommendation



Shoreside MPA:

Allowances: Shoreside fishing for fish species and crab; assumes no harvest from water craft or diving. All other extractive activities (including rocky intertidal harvest/collection of invertebrates, algae, and natural products) prohibited.

MPA:

Allowances: Commercial and sport crab & salmon. Exception: no commercial crab pots can be set in designated gravel substrate. All other extractive activities (including new ocean development) prohibited.
