Measure Description:

Makes changes to membership and powers of Travel Information Council.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Oregon Travel Information Council [Semi-Privatized]

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The fiscal impact of this statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Business, Transportation and Economic Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill provides for the transfer of responsibility for some rest areas from the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to the Travel Information Council, and also transfers the funds to the Council for the management, maintenance, improvement and development of specified roadside rest areas. These requirements will have a fiscal impact on the affected agencies.
