WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) to notify Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) when BOLI receives information from service members that they have been discriminated against based on military service. Requires service member's authorization to notify. Defines "uniformed service." Becomes effective July 1, 2012.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Successful cooperation between state agencies
- Ensuring continuity of protocol over time

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Bureau of Labor and Industries currently notifies the Department of Veterans' Affairs when it learns of discrimination allegations against service members. House Bill 4064 codifies this practice.
