## AN ACT

Relating to the Court of Appeals; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 2.540.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

**SECTION 1.** ORS 2.540 is amended to read:

- 2.540. (1) The Court of Appeals shall consist of [10] 13 judges.
- (2) A judge of the Court of Appeals shall be an elector of the county of the residence of the judge and be admitted to the practice of law in this state.
- (3) Each judge of the Court of Appeals shall hold office for a term of six years and until a successor is elected and qualified.
- SECTION 2. (1) The amendments to ORS 2.540 by section 1 of this 2012 Act become operative October 1, 2013.
- (2) As soon as possible after the amendments to ORS 2.540 by section 1 of this 2012 Act become operative, the Governor shall appoint persons to serve on the Court of Appeals in the positions created by the amendments to ORS 2.540 by section 1 of this 2012 Act until successors are elected and qualified.
