On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27. 1 2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 3 and insert: "SECTION 1. ORS 30.792 is amended to read: 3 "30.792. (1) As used in this section: 4 "(a)(A) 'Charitable [corporation] organization' [has the meaning given that term in ORS 5 128.620.] means a charitable organization, as defined in ORS 128.620, that: 6 7 "(i) Spends at least 65 percent of its revenues on charitable programs; and "(ii) Has a financially secure source of recovery for individuals who suffer harm as a 8 9 result of actions taken by a volunteer on behalf of the organization. 10 "(B) 'Charitable organization' does not include hospitals, intermediate care facilities or 11 long term care facilities, as those terms are defined in ORS 442.015. 12"(b) 'Health care provider' means [any person] an individual licensed in this state as a practi-13 tioner of one or more healing arts as described in ORS 31.740. 14 (c) 'Health clinic' means a public health clinic or a health clinic operated by a charitable 15[corporation] organization that provides primarily primary physical health, dental or mental health 16 services to low-income patients without charge or using a sliding fee scale based on the income of 17 the patient. 18 "(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, [no] a person may not maintain an 19 action for damages against: 20 "(a) A health care provider who voluntarily provides [to a charitable corporation any] assistance, 21services or advice [directly related to the charitable purposes of the corporation] through a charita-22ble organization if: 23 "(A) The assistance, services or advice that caused the damages are within the scope of the license of the health care provider; [or] and 24 25"(B) The health care provider was acting within the course and scope of the provider's 26 volunteer duties when the damages occurred; or 27(b) A health clinic for the assistance, services or advice provided by a health care provider 28described in paragraph (a) of this subsection. 29"(3) The immunity provided in this section [shall] does not apply to: 30 "(a) Any person who receives compensation other than reimbursement for expenses incurred by 31 the person providing [such] the assistance, services or advice described in subsection (2) of this section. 32(b) A person operating a motor vehicle, vessel, aircraft or other vehicle for which the 33 34 person or owner of the vehicle, vessel, aircraft or other vehicle is required to possess an 35operator's license or to maintain insurance.

1 "[(b)] (c) The liability of any person for damages resulting from the person's gross negligence

- $2 \quad \mbox{ or from the person's reckless, wanton or intentional misconduct. }$
- 3 "[(c)] (d) Any activity for which a person is otherwise strictly liable without regard to fault.".
