

House Bill 4046

Sponsored by Representative ROBLAN; Representatives DOHERTY, FREEMAN, HANNA, HOYLE, KENNEMER, THOMPSON, Senators MONNES ANDERSON, MONROE, MORSE, WINTERS (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Exempts certain accident only, specified disease and hospital indemnity insurance policies from payment of assessment on gross amount of premiums.

Takes effect July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to exemption from assessment on gross amount of premiums; amending ORS 743.960; and
3 prescribing an effective date.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 743.960 is amended to read:

6 743.960. As used in this section and ORS 743.961:

7 (1) "Gross amount of premiums" has the meaning given that term in ORS 731.808.

8 (2) "Health plan" means health insurance and insurance provided by a health care service con-
9 tractor as defined in ORS 750.005, excluding:

10 (a) Insurance policies covering vision only or dental only benefits;

11 (b) Medicare advantage plans;

12 (c) Medicare Part D plans;

13 (d) Long term care insurance;

14 (e) Health insurance issued to federal employees that is exempt from state taxes under federal
15 law;

16 (f) A policy of stop-loss coverage that meets the requirements of ORS 742.065;

17 (g) Insurance policies issued to supplement liability insurance coverage;

18 (h) Automobile medical payment insurance or insurance under which benefits are payable with
19 or without regard to fault and that is required by law to be contained in a liability insurance policy
20 or equivalent self-insurance;

21 (i) Reinsurance as defined in ORS 731.126;

22 (j) Workers compensation insurance; [*and*]

23 (k) Disability insurance; **and**

24 **(L) Accident only, specified disease and hospital indemnity policies, if the policies pay**
25 **benefits on an indemnity basis.**

26 **SECTION 2. This 2012 Act takes effect on July 1, 2013.**
