CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to election filing deadlines; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 254.085, for purposes of the general election to be held in November 2012, the Secretary of State, not later than the 60th day before the date of the general election, shall file with each county clerk a statement containing information regarding candidates for the offices of President and Vice President of the United States.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2012 Act is repealed on January 2, 2013.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect on its passage.
