

**HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1533**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 8 through 12 and insert:

2 “(A) Geothermal electricity generation or direct use of geothermal energy for space or water  
3 heating that reduces energy use from other sources by at least 20 percent from a level otherwise  
4 specified by law:

5 “(i) At the site of a public building; or

6 “(ii) Away from the site of a public building if the geothermal source is within this state and is  
7 in the same county as the public building or an adjacent county, if using energy from a geothermal  
8 source that is away from the site of the public building is more cost-effective than using geothermal  
9 energy from a source at the site of the public building, if generating or using geothermal energy at  
10 the site of the public building is not feasible and if in addition to geothermal energy the public  
11 building includes additional new capacity for renewable electricity generation.

12 “(B) Solar electricity generation, solar thermal generation or passive solar energy generation,  
13 if the system that employs passive solar energy generation reduces energy use from other sources  
14 by at least 20 percent from a level otherwise specified by law:

15 “(i) At the site of a public building; or

16 “(ii) Away from the site of a public building if the solar energy source is within this state and  
17 is in the same county as the public building or an adjacent county, if using energy from a solar  
18 energy source that is away from the site of the public building is more cost-effective than using solar  
19 energy from a source at the site of the public building, if generating or using solar energy at the  
20 site of the public building is not feasible and if in addition to solar energy the public building in-  
21 cludes additional new capacity for renewable electricity generation.”.

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
