

Hello,

as a severely medication-induced immune suppressed person, the web site states that I would not be eligible for unemployment. (i.e., available for work)

I have severe Rheumatoid Arthritis and take immune-suppression meds to maintain a minimal level of mobility, including weekly chemotherapy (methotrexate) and Enbrel injectijons.

I need to self quarantine because of my high risk of contracting COVID-19 and being seriously affected. (i.e., my last blood test taken 3/11/2020 shows a B-cell count of ZERO).

Because under the current guidelines, I remain "available to work", what do you suggest I do?

from the web site: "If you are home sick because you are sick with COVID-19 or other flu like symptoms that prevent you from going into work, you are considered able to work.

If you are quarantined, but not sick, you are considered able to work."
