I have heard rumors that there will be a stay at home order in our State. If that happens, I will take two courses of action. First, I will hire an attorney to declare myself, my employees, and my business as essential to the state economy. I will try to run the business as much as I can given the circumstances.

Second, I will sell all our apartments and houses, take the proceeds, and move to any state that does not have a stay at home order in place.

The politicians need to decide if they really want the small business person to be shut down in the state. This is bad policy and very one sided.

My employees and my business mean a lot to me. I will do whatever is reasonable and within the law to do what is right. The stay at home order would be a huge mistake in judgement in my opinion.
