I have a small number of rental houses that I accumulated for income in my later years. I am 73 years old now. I have no desire to evict any of my renters as I care about their welfare during this crisis. I have only about \$1000 of monthly income from my Social Security. If the government abates my rental income with no subsidy to me for the loss of income to cover my mortgage payments, taxes and insurance this will pose a severe hardship for me. It may even cost a foreclosure of my property. I urge you to consider the situation of land lords as well as renters. - Fred Purdy
