While tenants may have some relief from paying rent, my mortgage company will still require me to make my house payments regardless of the impact on my job, renters or life. I am asking that for the sake of the whole, meaning all residents of Oregon that you make a clear and concise plan to help small landlords be able to weather the crisis in front of us.
