I understand that only the elderly and or ill inmates are being considered for release in the event of an outbreak at any of the facilities here in Oregon. I might wonder why just them and not low risk and short timers as other states are considering, this would free up a lot of beds and give more "social distancing" space. All incarcerated man and woman are human beings and should be kept safe. Feel free to pass any decisions that are made or being considered on to my by email. And yes I have a son incarcerated due home this fall, blue collar crime and low risk and I do want him to walk out a healthy young man, not on a stretcher or in a body bag.
