SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires public schools to make available, at no cost, menstrual products in at least 50 percent of bathrooms at schools with students in any grade from grade 7 through 12. Takes effect July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to menstrual products in schools; and prescribing an effective date.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Each public school district or public charter school shall make available, at

5 no cost, menstrual products in at least 50 percent of the bathrooms at every school with
