SUMMARY

Modifies requirements for alternative education programs, including applicable laws, funding provisions, notice requirements, reporting requirements, oversight requirements and requirements related to special education and 504 Plans. Requires alternative education programs to ensure that at least 50 percent of teachers and administrators are licensed and to have criminal records check of all nonlicensed employees who have direct, unsupervised contact with school children.

Prohibits district school boards from authorizing superintendent to enter into and approve contract that provides for members of law enforcement agency to be assigned to schools of school district.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.
