It is my understanding that SB408 will authorize Oregon Health Authority to oversee all medical licensing boards in the state of Oregon. Those who function within OHA are unelected bureaucrats who have no intimate knowledge of the practice of medicine and do not understand the sacred relationship between doctor and patient. State medical licensing boards set the scope of practice for their practitioners based on their training and skills. If bureaucrats step into this process without intimate knowledge of what various types of practitioners provide, they will likely create a void in health care services as they seek to remove modalities they do not understand.

The so-called "standard of care" that is set forth by insurance companies already creates restrictions on access to less invasive and pharmaceutically directed health care.
