Oregon License Directory

What is it...

The Oregon License Directory is a program that was created to capture all license types that a business may need to apply for.

The Directory holds license information for city, county, and state agencies.

The original goal was to integrate with a business wizard to ensure a new or existing business could easily locate the information for a license they may need to do business in Oregon.

History

How it all began

House Bill 2643 (2013) mandated that all state and local government agencies record licenses impacting small business and update annually.

All local agencies and state agencies that have functions related to the issuance of licenses, permits and registrations for which fees and fee-related regulations are imposed on small businesses must:

- Report information in a manner to be designated by the Secretary of State By rule for inclusion in the Oregon License Directory, including but not limited to:
 - Information regarding the average time to process and issue licenses, permits and registrations for which fees are imposed on small businesses
 - The number of active licenses, permits and registrations
 - Review and update the information required on or before July 1, but not later than September 1 of each year

How it Works

User Management

Agencies sign up for an account that they can use to create, edit or remove licenses for their specific agency.




The public user may search by:

The Oregon License Directory Application provides an improved search for business license information to assist entrepreneurs in starting or expanding a business. The application also provides the public an avenue to obtain license holders information. The License Directory Administration Interface provides the Agencies with a streamlined application for all administrative functions needed to support the License Directory Application including license management, user management and access to reports, notifications, and other administrative functions.

The Oregon License Directory does not include license holder information and is not a place to view every individual business that has applied for or holds a license in Oregon.
