**Summary of Subcommittee Action**

House Bill 2530 creates a 30 member Task Force on Comprehensive Revenue Restructuring to advise the Governor and Legislature on revenue restructuring for local and state government. It also creates a seven member Oregon Revenue Advisory Council to provide technical analysis for the task force and to make recommendations for consideration by the Task Force. The Legislative Revenue Office will provide staff support for both the Task Force and the Council.

The Subcommittee approved \$117,011 General Fund and established one limited duration support position (0.50 full-time equivalent) to the Legislative Revenue Office for this purpose. The approved funding will support this position and costs for legislative per diem, travel, and other meeting related expenses for the Task Force and Council.
