EFFECTIVE DATE: On passage.

GOVERNOR'S BUDGET: This bill is not anticipated by the Governor's recommended budget.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE: This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

COMMENTS: The measure prohibits siting a casino in an incorporated city unless that city and adjacent cities' electors approve, and exempts tribal casinos including those conducted under Indian Gaming Regulatory Act and federal regulations.

The League of Oregon Cities indicates that the measure could create a fiscal impact on cities if the measure is on a special election ballot. The exact fiscal is indeterminate as election costs vary city to city based on population size and county in which the city is located.
