**REVENUE IMPACT OF** 

## Measure Description:

Adds unlawful distribution of tobacco products to list of crimes to which criminal forfeiture applies.

## **Revenue Impact:**

Impact is minimal with about \$50,000 of added revenue to be distributed according to the CFAA formulas.

## Impact Explanation:

The instruments and vehicles that will be forfeited in this process are usually not of the highest value. However, the benefit is greater in the punitive and preventative value. Additionlly, having the ability to seek forfeiture of the delivery vehicle would allow for recoup of some of the costs associated with the forfeiture and perhaps some of the evaded taxes owed in satisfaction of the criminal judgment.
