## **Measure Description:**

Establishes Education Enterprise Coordinating Commission. Specifies 21 members, terms and duties. Requires Commission to establish collaboratives to administer programs.

Mandates commission to establish Oregon Collaborative for Educational Excellence. Directs collaborative to provide system for professional development of teachers, administrators and nonlicensed personnel.

Establishes Education Enterprise Coordinating Commission Account. Transfers \$600,000 per year from the State School Fund to the account.

Takes effect July 1, 2007.

## **Impact Explanation:**

State School Fund and local school and ESD formula dollars are shared 95.25% for school districts and 4.75% for ESDs. School district revenue decreases about 85 cents per year per weighted student and ESD revenue about 4 cents.
