Measure Description:

Establishes Oregon State police Patrol Division Fund separate and distinct from the general fund. Diverts 1% of the general fund revenue to the new fund. Continuously appropriates money in fund the State Police Patrol division.

Impact Explanation:

The bill essentially partitions the general fund by dedicating 1% to the Oregon State Police patrol function. It is not clear however, if this dedication is exclusive of the patrol function. The forecast is likely to change based on the May-15 the forecast, but the estimate form the general fund to the new patrol fund will be also a mirror image with a different sign.
