## Measure Description:

Appropriates \$260.0 million from the General Fund to the School Improvement Fund for grants to school districts, Youth Corrections Education Program and the Juvenile Detention Education Program to fund activities related to increasing student achievement.

Takes effect July 1, 2007.

## Impact Explanation:

The assumption is that the School Improvement Fund will be equally divided between the two years in the biennium. The funds are distributed proportional to weighted students.
