Measure Description:

Lowers the minimum age for required school attendance from 7 years old to 6 years old. Requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules to ensure appropriate grade level placement for 6 year olds. Specifies rule adoption prior to 2008-09.

Revenue Impact:

Impact Explanation:

Most 6 year old children are attending a public school or legal alternative. Any additional 6 year old public school students will likely result in only a minor shift in State School Fund revenue among school districts.
