**EFFECTIVE DATE:** January 1, 2008.

**GOVERNOR'S BUDGET:** This bill is not included in the Governor's budget.

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE:** This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**COMMENTS:** The measure would authorize the formation of manufactured housing park non-profit cooperatives and allow such cooperatives to become eligible to qualify for Housing and Community Services Department loans and technical assistance. The measure also increases the loan guarantee amount from 25% to 50%.

This fiscal impact statement is issued for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Consumer Protection to the House Committee on Revenue. The Department is in the process of revising and clarifying its original fiscal impact information provided to the Legislative Fiscal Office. A detailed fiscal impact statement will be issued for the measure when it is considered by the House Committee on Revenue.
