WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows service members to request a stay of administrative proceedings under certain circumstances.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Federal Serviceman's Relief Act of 2003 ٠

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: The amendment removes the requirement that the service member is called into active service for 30 or more consecutive days, and adds language for clarification.

BACKGROUND: Under current statutes members of the Oregon National Guard who are called into active federal service under Title 10 may apply to a court for relief with respect to any obligation or liability and they may also apply for relief in proceedings of a civil judicial proceeding.

House Bill 2093 would allow relief for the service members in administrative hearings under Title 10 service and would include Title 32 service and active state duty.
