WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows members of the armed forces to request a stay of administrative proceedings, or relief from any obligation or liability awarded in an administrative proceeding, under certain circumstances. Extends benefits of act to Oregon National Guard members who are called into active state duty.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Federal law
- Need for stays in administrative proceeding
- Domestic proceedings

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Under ORS 399.238, members of the Oregon National Guard who are called into active federal service may apply to a court for a stay of a civil proceeding, or for relief from any obligation or liability incurred before the active service began. The court "shall" grant the stay of proceedings, and "may" grant relief from liability, unless the court determines that the member's ability to appear or comply with the order is not "materially affected" by the active service. HB 2093A would extend the statute to members of the Oregon National Guard who are called into active state duty, and to administrative proceedings and orders.
