WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Eliminates prorated license fee for licenses that are issued by OLCC for less than a full year.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Provisions of the measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: License fees levied by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) are based on two factors: the geographic area where the business is located and the license issuance date. Because the issuance date is not established at the time that an application is received, applicants cannot submit their fees at the time they apply for a license. This often leaves applicants being frustrated or confused about when to pay their required fees.

HB 2169 not only helps alleviate these problems, but will also help facilitate the OLCC's plans of integrating to online application submissions and fee payments during the 2007-09 biennium.
