**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Clarifies statute under which a person may apply for a hearing regarding the assessment of civil penalty by the Director of the Employment Department for a violation concerning the transfer or acquisition of a trade or business.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** HB 2249 corrects an oversight in cross-referencing sections of law from HB 2124 (2005), which prohibits businesses from transferring or acquiring a business primarily for the purpose of obtaining a lower unemployment tax rate. While HB 2124 referenced ORS 657.283 as the basis for the Oregon Employment Department to request and hold a hearing on state unemployment tax dumping decisions, the bill failed to add a reference to ORS 657.480, relating to the effect of transferring of a trade or business, into ORS 657.283.
