WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Sets fees for issuance of motor vehicle registration plates by determining actual cost of manufacturing the plates and rounding up to the next highest half-dollar, then adding \$1 for a single plate and \$2 for each pair of plates.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Distribution of vehicle registration fee revenues

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Under ORS 803.570, the Oregon Department of Transportation establishes vehicle registration fees by rule, however the fee may not exceed \$3 for a single plate or \$5 for a set of plates. HB 2269 sets the fee by determining the actual cost of manufacturing the plates and rounding up to the next highest half-dollar and then adding \$1 for a single plate or \$2 for each pair of plates. Moneys collected to cover costs of manufacturing plates are allocated to the Oregon Department of Transportation and the additional fees collected (\$1 for single plate/\$2 for pair of plates) will be allocated 60 percent to counties and 40 percent to cities (ORS 366.747).
