WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires the Department of Corrections, beginning in 2012 and every six years thereafter, to conduct a study of the actual costs of the counties providing management, support services and supervision for offenders on parole, probation, post-prison supervision or sentenced to 12 months or less. Requires the department to use these results to adjust the rates the state will reimburse counties.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Need to visit costs periodically

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Replaces the bill.

BACKGROUND: In Oregon, counties supervise offenders on parole, probation or post-prison supervision for commission of a felony. Counties also house in the county jail offenders sentenced to 12 months or less for commission of a felony. The State of Oregon reimburses counties for managing these offenders. ORS 423.483 sets forth the baseline funding for county reimbursement.
