BACKGROUND: The Washington County Commuter Rail is a transportation line that currently runs between Beaverton and Wilsonville. HB 2472 creates a task force to explore the possibility of extending the rail southerly from Wilsonville to Salem.

The task force consists of seventeen members with Legislative Administration Committee providing staff support. Members' expenses are not reimbursed. All agencies of state government are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties.
