**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Permits a state employee or state officer to authorize deduction from salary or wages for the Oregon Veteran's Home Account.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Current fund raising activities
- Oregon Veterans' Home does not receive any General Funds dollars

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** The Oregon Veterans' Home provides intermediate and skilled nursing, and Alzheimer's disease care to some of Oregon's vulnerable veteran population. Care is provided in a 75,000 square foot, single-story facility through a contract with a private care provider. The Home has a maximum capacity of 151 patients.

House Bill 2630 would allow state employees to voluntarily donate funds from their salary to the Oregon Veterans' Home.
