**EFFECTIVE DATE:** 91<sup>st</sup> Day After Sine Die Adjournment

**GOVERNOR'S BUDGET:** This bill is anticipated by the Governor's recommended budget.

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE:** This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**COMMENTS:** This measure extends the current sunset of the Medicaid managed care assessment from January 1, 2008 to October 1, 2009. The repeal date of the assessment is also extended from January 2, 2010 to January 2, 2012.

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Revenue. A detailed fiscal impact statement will be issued for the measure when it is considered by the House Committee Revenue.

The Legislative Fiscal Office believes this measure warrants a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means Committee.
