EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Under current law, contractors or subcontractors must file a bond in the amount of \$30,000 with the Construction Contractors Board before starting work on a contract or subcontract. Also, new businesses owned by minorities, women or an emerging small business have the right to not obtain a public works bond for up to one year. HB 2776A would extend that exemption to four years.
