WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Prohibits district attorneys and deputy district attorneys from engaging in private practice of law.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Salary for district attorneys part of governor's budget ٠

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: ORS 8.726 prohibits any district attorney or deputy district attorney who makes more than \$18,000 a year from engaging in the private practice of law (supplementing income by taking different cases on the side besides criminal prosecution). There is a specific exception in subsection (2) for the district attorneys of Gilliam, Sherman, Wallowa and Wheeler counties. Presently, the district attorneys for Gilliam, Sherman and Wheeler counties are parttime only.

HB 2799 removes the exception for the district attorneys for Gilliam, Sherman, Wallowa and Wheeler counties, who would now be prevented from supplementing their respective incomes through additional legal work.
