WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Exempts Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) and health centers that serve medically-underserved individuals and rural areas from professional corporation requirements.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Corporate practice of medicine prohibition law enacted in 1947
- The need for FQHC's to directly employ physicians
- Concerns raised by health centers regarding employment of licensed health professionals
- Clarification necessary for health centers

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Removes provisions that allow nonprofit corporations to employ health professionals if nonprofit corporations serves medically underserved individuals, serves rural areas or is a FOHC.

BACKGROUND: Under current law, professional corporations formed for practicing medicine are required to adhere to requirements regarding qualifications of directors (a majority being licensed physicians).
