Requires Board review and approve all insurance rates, rating plans and rating systems filed or used by insurer, rating organization or advisory organization. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No Amendment

**BACKGROUND:** House Bill 3107 would create the Insurance Rate Review Board consisting of five mebers appointed by the Governor. The Board would review and approve or disapprove all rates, rating plans and rating systems filed or used by an insurer or filed by a rating or advisory organization on behalf of an insurer.
