**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires a city with a charter requiring annexation elections to allow electors in an “island” territory to be annexed to vote on annexation. Requires a majority of votes cast in the city and the territory combined to approve annexation. Requires that proclamation of annexation contain a legal description of each territory annexed.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Provisions of the measure

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

- Adds “if any” to clarify that a requirement to allow electors from the territory to be annexed to participate in annexation election applies only if there are electors in that territory

**BACKGROUND:** Some cities require an election to decide an annexation request. It is unclear under current laws, whether residents in a territory to be annexed, are eligible to participate in an election regarding annexation, because they live outside the corporate boundaries of the city holding the election.
