WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires a city with a charter requiring annexation elections to allow electors in an "island" territory to be annexed to vote on annexation. Requires a majority of votes cast in the city and the territory combined to approve annexation. Requires that proclamation of annexation contain a legal description of each territory annexed.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Limited applicability of measure to jurisdictions that require annexation elections
- Authority of cities to authorize vote outside of their jurisdiction

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No Amendment.

BACKGROUND: Some cities require an election to decide an annexation request. It is unclear under current laws whether residents in a territory to be annexed are eligible to participate in an election regarding annexation because they live outside the corporate boundaries of the city holding the election.
