WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Establishes Oregon Main Street Program in Oregon Economic and Community Development Department (OECDD). Authorizes OECDD to assist local governments in establishing downtown revitalization programs by providing technical assistance and grant funding. Authorizes OECDD to make rules regarding program implementation.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Transfers program from Department of State Parks and Recreation to OECDD.
