ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Provisions of measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Sunriver service district was established in 2002. Most of the roads within the service district are owned by the Sunriver Homeowners Association. Currently, these privately owned roads do not fall within the Vehicle Code's definition of highway. Most of the vehicle code's traffic violations only apply to highways. HB 3445A adds "premises open to the public that are owned by a homeowners association and whose boundaries are contained within a service district established on or before July 1, 2002" to the definition of highway for the purposes of enforcing traffic offenses.
