WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes the Department of Agriculture (ODA) to receive and distribute grant funds for any purpose related to the laws administered or enforced by the Department. Revises language related to contracts.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Lack of clear authority for ODA to provide grant payments
- Purpose of additional language related to tribes

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Adds Indian tribes and any department to agency of the United States to list of entities which may receive grants from the Department.

BACKGROUND: The Oregon Department of Agriculture currently lacks clear statutory authority to enter into contracts and agreements and to receive and distribute grant funds. In a recent circumstance, this led to another agency fulfilling this role for ODA. HB 3494-A amends ORS 561.240 to clarify ODA's authority and would allow the department to enter into contracts, agreements, receive or issue grants with a variety of entities.
