**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires Department of Human Services (DHS) and Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to work together to collect data and prepare a report on citizen and legal residence requirements for public assistance programs provided by DHS and DHS providers. Requires report to Legislature by July 1, 2008.

**BACKGROUND:** House Bill 3516-A defines public assistance as those services detailed in ORS 411.010, including temporary assistance for needy families, general assistance, medical assistance, assistance provided by the Oregon Supplemental Income Program, and benefits and services for persons with disabilities, publicly funded or government-subsidized housing, food or nutrition programs, and unemployment benefits.
