WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Memorializes former State Senator Ted Hallock, who served in the Oregon Legislative Assembly from 1963 through 1983.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Quality and dynamism of Sen. Hallock's floor speeches
- Issues that Sen. Hallock worked on remain prevalent

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: According to *The Oregonian* reporter Harry Esteve, Ted Hallock "is best known for his years in the state Senate, where he was seen as an idea-a-minute maverick willing to take radical steps to protect Oregon's rugged landscapes and way of life. He teamed with former Gov. Tom McCall and a Republican Senate colleague named Hector MacPherson to push through the series of land-use laws that made Oregon a national leader in protection of farm and forestland."

Hallock died December 16, 2006 in Portland.
