EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** The United States has free trade agreements with several Asian nations, including Singapore, Thailand, and most recently South Korea. HJM 13A urges Congress to negotiate a free trade agreement with Taiwan. HJM 13A specifies that the agreement should include guarantees that the State of Oregon has the right to determine its own public policy regarding such things as human rights, environmental protections, and labor standards.
