**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Corrects grammar and punctuation errors in Oregon law. Deletes obsolete references.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Need to make non-substantive, technical corrections to old Oregon statutes
- Court of Appeals decision in *Bates v. Gordon* (2006)
- Relating clause specifies changes are technical and non-substantive

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.
