WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires employee benefit plan and health insurer to reimburse state Medicaid expenditures made for benefit of enrollee under specified circumstances. Requires employee benefit plan and health insurer to provide eligibility and claims to state Medicaid agency upon request. Declares emergency; takes effect upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Clarifies health insurance plans that must provide eligibility claims to state Medicaid agency upon request. Clarifies implementation procedures.
