**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Creates the State Drinking Water Advisory Committee to advise and assist the Department of Human Services (DHS).

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** A State Drinking Water Advisory Committee is currently authorized under the Oregon Department of Human Services Public Health Division to advise the department on safe drinking water issues. This advisory committee has operated at the department's discretion since 1981. Because drinking water concerns intersect with a number of different state agencies, the department believes codifying the Drinking Water Advisory Committee in statute would broaden the committee's role to serve multiple state agencies.
